Trafficking

According to the best informed estimates, there are 27 million people in modern slavery today. Over half are from India. This takes many forms including bonded labour (affecting 15 million children), sex trafficking (1.3 million children), ritualised prostitution (250,000 women and girls), beggary (as portrayed in Slumdog Millionaire), harvesting of body parts and abusive domestic service.

The vast majority of Indians trafficked are Dalits.

Dalits

Formerly known as 'Untouchables', Dalits fall below India's ancient caste system. Along with tribal peoples they make up 23% of India's population. These 250 million people are considered to be outcastes, or 'unborn' as it would have been better to have never been born. They face humiliating discrimination, violence and abuse. They are among the poorest and most oppressed people in the world.

Trafficked Dalits are robbed of both their dignity and their freedom.

Freedom

DFN UK is responding to requests from Dalit leaders to mount a campaign against the trafficking of Dalits, to speak up for the oppressed and to free the slaves. Our Indian partners - OMIF - are involved in an anti-trafficking initiative of prevention, rescue, rehabilitation and reintegration.

In the UK we will lobby for international support of anti-trafficking measures in India, as well as support a range of anti-trafficking projects in India, including education, healthcare, economic and legal initiatives.

Support the Campaign

As we launch the campaign in the UK we need your support. This includes financial support

We rely on the help of many volunteers but we also need to employ staff, such as a campaign manager. In addition we need to fund materials and media to raise the profile of Dalit trafficking as a human rights issue, and to get the message out there. We are communicating with supporters across the country, including those who are part of our community action groups. We are also making links with politicians and other people of influence, in addition to organisations with whom we can form alliances where our aims coincide. All this involves costs.
